Proceedings of the IQAC meeting held on 05.07.2022.

Principal initiated the meeting giving thanks to all the members for attending the said meeting. The convener was asked to give a brief summary of the developments that has taken place since the last meeting.

Principal informed the members that a memorandum of understanding has been signed between this institution and Hulladek Recycling Private Limited for disposal and management of E-waste on 25.04.2022.

Principal informed the members that two sanitary napkin vending machines have been installed in the main building of the college and 1500 napkins were donated to the college students free of cost.

- 1. All the members mentioned the necessity of sufficient power back up system for smooth functioning of computers and other important electrical instruments used in different laboratories. For this purpose a heavy duty generator needs to be installed.
- 2. Drainage system adjacent to OBC boys' hostel requires renovation and reconstruction.
- Dr Subhro Ghosal emphasized on the utility of biometric attendance system for convenience of the recording of leave accounts.
- 4. Dr Sarbani Bhattacharyya mentioned the importance of exposure of the students to diverse teaching and learning atmosphere and exchange of faculty members for betterment of the teaching-learning process.
- 5. Dr.Sarbani Bhattacharya mentioned that in view of the economic hardships faced by a large section of students, employment opportunities are of paramount importance to them. However job opportunities in the organized sector were already depressed. The IQAC coordinator suggested that students and the neihbouring folk especially women could be skilled to become self employed. After a long discussion it was, decided that an incubation cell be formed which will work towards encouraging students towards a career in entrpreneurship. Dr.Chaitali Bhattacharya suggested that mushroom cultivation was a very low investment enterprise which could be be initiated in the first pahse. It was decided that the department of zoology be requested to look at the feasibility of the venture. The college would provide the infrastructural support and initial seed money. Thereafter it would be expected to become self-sustaining.
- 6. In view of the devastating pandemic situation that has created bottleneck to the classroom

Principal initiated the meeting giving thanks to all the members for attending the said meeting. The convener was asked to give a brief summary of the developments that has taken place since the last meeting.

Principal informed the members that a memorandum of understanding has been signed between this institution and Netaji Subhas Open University for opening Learner Support Centre/ Study Centre for Under Graduate and Post Graduate Degree (Non-Lab) programme of Netaji Subhas Open University at A.P.C College Study centre. Memorandum of understanding has also been signed with Panihati Mahavidyalaya, Rishi Bankim Chandra College for Women, Hiralal Mazumdar Memorial College for Women, Derozio Memorial College and Brainware University for collaboration in academic, research, social, cultural and consultancy activities. MOU with Sarojini Naidu College for Women has been renewed. Three seminars namely "Unsung Heroes of India's Freedom Struggle", "Awareness Camp cum Seminar on Blood cancer, thalassemia and other blood related disease and stem cell transplantation: A New Hope" and "HUMAN DEVELOPMENT: A multidisciplinary Subject and It's Prospect" have also been organized.

Principal informed the members that one 160 KVA generator has been installed in the main campus and the old one is shifted to the post graduate campus.

- 1. Prayer of the department of Molecular Biology and Biotechnology for the introduction of Honours course in the subject be considered and necessary steps be taken in this respect.
- 2. Fresh requisition be placed to the West Bengal College Service for recommending the name of a candidate to the post of Assistant Professor in Electronics (RP No.54, Reserved for ST)
- 3. Dr. Nimairatan Adhikari pointed out that elementary computer course for the students of Humanities general stream be introduced in order to equip them for procurement of job. For this purpose, a utility-based curriculum be framed and the parent university be moved for sanctioning of the curriculum and the course. APC college computer centre be requested to look after the course.
- 4. Dr Sarbani Bhattacharyya mentioned that Teachers' benefit committee be strengthened to

- 7. Dr. Sarbani Bhattacharyya pointed out that initiative needs to be taken for awareness programme on intellectual property rights and entrepreneurship. She also suggested that Women's cell should take the initiative for self employment of girl students.

Principal initiated the meeting giving thanks to all the members for attending the said meeting. The convener was asked to give a brief summary of the developments that has taken place since the last meeting.

Principal informed the members that the college has initiated the process for introduction of certificate course on "Utility based basics of Computer Application" primarily for students from humanities stream with a fee of Rs.300/- for the entire course in collaboration with APC College Computer Centre at the college premises. He also said that a course on "Basic techniques in self defense-Tejaswini" will be offered in collaboration with the traditional Shoto Karate association of Bengal. West Bengal State University be moved for approval of the syllabi of the above mentioned Certificate courses to be offered in the college. Memorandum of understanding (MOU) has been signed with Vidyasagar College for Women and Ramkrishna Sarada Mission Vivekananda Vidyabhavan in order to foster academic and research activities. An interesting and useful seminar on "Chemistry behind Phytochemicals and their Medicinal Importance in Curing Various Diseases of Human Being" has been hosted.

- Jaydev Dasbiswas pointed out the necessity for cloud based storage of data pertinent to NAAC portal. He proposed that steps need to be taken for procuring tools for assessment & accreditation.
- Chaitali Bhattacharyya mentioned that West Bengal College Service Commission be moved for filling up the teaching post of the department of Physics fallen vacant on account of resignation tendered by Dr. Sukhamoy Bhattacharyya.
- 3. Dr Sarbani Bhattacharyya mentioned the necessity of lift facility in the VTG building in order to facilitate the movement of sick and aged teachers and economization of time.
- 4. Dr.Sandip Saha raised the issue of strengthening research and guidance cell of the institution to look after the matters related to research and publications. He also proposed to take initiative for organization of a National Seminar on Analytical Methods for Social Science in order to comply with the growing demand of more intensive research activities in the realm of social science.



Principal initiated the meeting giving thanks to all the members for attending the said meeting.

The convener was asked to give a brief summary of the developments that has taken place since the last meeting.

Principal informed the members that papers of fifteen fulltime teachers for promotion have been processed. He also mentioned that pay of eight state funded teachers has been upgraded as per the existing rules and regulations.

Principal also informed the members that MOU has been signed with Anudip Foundations, Kalinagar Mahavidyalaya and Bhawanipur Education Society for exchanging academic and infrastructural facilities. MOU with Netaji Subhas Open University has been renewed. Two seminars have been organized on "Mangroves of Sundarban and it's Medicinal values" and "Recent Trends in Machine Learning and Data Science (Enhancing Insurance Claim Predictions: A Comparative Analysis of Machine Learning Models)". A Film Exhibition & Interactive Workshop has also been hosted.

- All the members indicated the necessity of installation of CC Camera in the newly constructed 3rd floors of the Main Building, VT Building and also in newly constructed Canteen Building of the college for safety and security of the students, teaching and nonteaching staff..
- Chaitali Bhattacharyya requested to explore the possibility of opening post graduate course in Zoology.
- 3. Dr Sarbani Bhattacharyya mentioned that some immediate steps need to be taken to increase the number of students in some conventional subjects like Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Sanskrit etc. Academic subcommittee of the college should look after the matter.
- 4. Dr. Subhro Ghosal emphasized the maintenance of instruments and electrical appliance on a regular basis in order to increase their longevity. He also proposed that the departments should be given adequate number of computers for their smooth functioning in respect of storage of valuable data.
